
Classic Hopscotch Game

How to Play Hopscotch - Playing Classic Hopscotch

• Draw a hopscotch design on the ground with your piece of chalk.



Stand/Start Here



- Throw a flat stone or similar object (rock, small beanbag, shell, button, plastic toy) to land on square one.
- Hop/land with both feet on square 2 (left foot) and 3 (right foot), then 1 foot onto #4 repeat through the squares, and turn around standing on 1 foot on square #10 and hop back to starting spot skipping the one you have your object on.
- Pick up the object on your way back.
- Pass the Object on to the next person.
- First one to successfully land their rock or object on 1-10 and hop through the hopscotch course is the winner.

4 Square Game



4 square is a great game to play with the whole family. Draw your own 4 square court with sidewalk chalk, mark a number from 1 to 4 in each square and use a bouncy ball to play this game. Each player stands in each of the squares, and the player in square 4 starts by bouncing the ball in their square and then hitting it towards one of the other squares. The receiving player then hits the ball to any other player. The ball must bounce in the receiving players's square once and they must hit it to another player before it bounces a second time. If the player misses a square or the ball bounces a second time before they hit it, they are "out". If there are more than 4 players, the player who is out goes to the end of the line to start back at 1. If there are only 4 players, the player who is out would move back to 1 and the other players move up a number – 4 being the highest!
