What Do Homemakers Do?

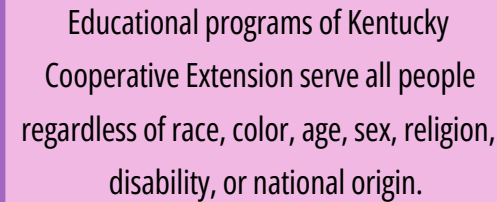
- Over 20,000 Volunteer Service Hours
