GENERAL PURPOSE:

Help supervise youth, ages 9-13, in a camping facility. Support 4-H professionals, volunteers and members in conducting meaningful educational experiences to help youth develop social skills.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- o Along with the Adult Leader, reside in a cabin with campers. A teen leader must never be alone with campers while in the cabin. An adult must always be present when in the cabin.
- o Assist in orienting campers to the camp and program.
- o Help guide campers in making choices of classes.
- o Be on the alert for homesickness or other issues.
- o Check health and safety needs of campers.
- o Help take care of campers' personal property.
- o Help create positive attitude of campers in cabin.
- o Maintain order in cabin or group.
- o Assist campers during class periods.
- o Have a "quiet" cabin after lights are out.
- Watch for fatigue in camp group.
- O Assist in rainy day programs by supervising games in cabin, etc.
- Report daily on progress, situation, problems and successes to County Extension Agents and attend Staff meetings as requested.
- o Assist with program planning and evaluation.
- Assist Camp Staff, adult leaders or Extension Agents, upon request, in such areas as meditations, flags, crafts, etc.
- Work with campers in planning and conducting such programs as flag raising and lowering and meditations.
- o All leaders must attend camp training programs offered at the county or multi-county level.
- o All leaders are ultimately responsible to the Camp Program Director for the camp in which they are involved.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- o Have a genuine interest in working with youth.
- o Have a sincere interest in 4-H camp.
- o Be friendly, cooperative and have a high degree of personal responsibility.
- o Possess tolerance, consideration and fair-mindedness.
- o Be sympathetic and understanding.
- o Be enthusiastic.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- O Must provide own transportation to meetings and activities.
- O Self starter; be able to work with minimal supervision from professional staff.
- O Effective communication skills.
- O A sincere interest in working with extension staff, volunteers, parents, and youth.
- Organizational skills; ability to organize information and materials in a timely manner.
- O Must be 15 years or older at time of camp (Counselors in training must be 14 years old)
- O Ability to get along with others
- O Willingness to follow rules

BENEFITS:

- o The opportunity to work with youth and/or adults providing positive support and growth experience.
- o Receive intrinsic and extrinsic rewards at volunteer recognition events.
- o Volunteer development opportunities.
- o Opportunity to share your skills, talents, and interest.
- o Orientation provided by extension staff.
- o Research shows that volunteering promotes improved health.
- O The opportunity to make a difference in the life of the child
